ELIGIBILITY for JUNIOR COURSER AND QUALIFY COURSER

Only purebred Afghans, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or part of an AKC registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sight hounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the suffix titles of QC, JC, SC and MC. Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed disqualifications apply.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hounds must be one year of (age or older) on the day of the test. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. All hounds will be examined for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered. Bitches in season may not compete.

- The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions.
- An **enforced \$5.00 fine** will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in the test.
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judge and handler of the hounds running in the test will be permitted near the lure machine.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
- Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail, but *will* be acknowledged by email if email address is provided on entry. **IMPORTANT:** FAX, E-MAIL or PHONE entries cannot be accepted.

PRACTICE WILL BE HELD AFTER THE TESTING ON SUNDAY IF WEATHER, EQUIPMENT AND DAYLIGHT PERMIT.

Practice is \$2.00 per dog per run

Field and Equipment Information: A battery-powered, continuous loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags. The field is mowed grass and basically level.

TEST HOURS: NOON until dusk
ROLL CALL: 10:00 A.M. for all breeds
Earlier roll call for Field Trial Committee, club members, lure operator, and judge.
(Roll Call is the time when participants are expected to check-in by—check-ins is followed by inspection for fitness, lameness or “In Season” females)
If you do not check-in by assigned time, you will not be able to participate
You will be expected to have complete info on your dog

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North/West: I-64 east to exit 234, Rte 199 east towards Lightfoot. Exit Rte. 199 at Monticello Ave. and bear right onto Rte. 321/Rte. 5000 west. Proceed straight for approximately 7 miles. Monticello Ave or Rte. 5000 will turn into John Tyler Hwy or Rte. 5. The park will be the last driveway on the right hand side of Rte. 5 before the Chickahominy River Bridge.

From the East: I-64 west to exit 242 towards Jamestown, Rte. 199 west. At Monticello Ave exit bear left and continue with *From the North/West* directions.

From the South: Take Rte. 31 north to the Jamestown Ferry. After crossing the river continue on Rte. 31 to Rte. 614 (first left after the Jamestown Beach Campsites). Stay on Rte. 614 to Rte. 5, make a left onto Rte. 5 and proceed to the Chickahominy Riverfront Park on right.

From the West: Take Rte. 5 east from I-295. Take a left after crossing the Chickahominy River Bridge into the park.

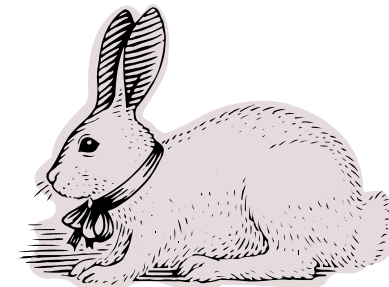
