ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Afghans, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or part of an AKC registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sight hounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the suffix titles of QC, JC, SC and MC. Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed disqualifications apply.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

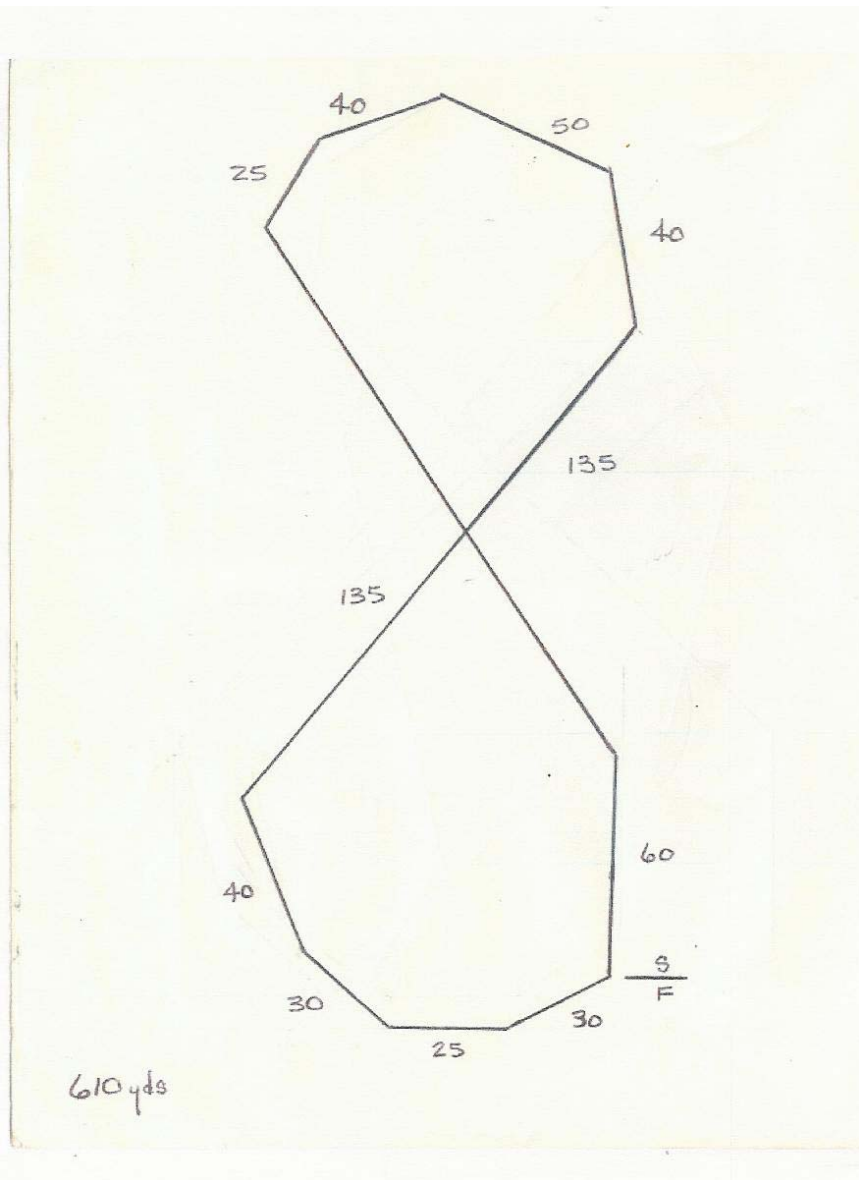
Hounds must be one year of (age or older) on the day of the test. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. All hounds will be examined for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered. Bitches in season may not compete.

- The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions.
- An **enforced \$5.00 fine** will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in the test.
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judge and handler of the hounds running in the test will be permitted near the lure machine.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
- Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail, but *will* be acknowledged by email if email address is provided on entry. **IMPORTANT:** FAX, E-MAIL or PHONE entries cannot be accepted.

NICE THINGS TO KNOW

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North/West: Take I-64 east to I-664 south towards Suffolk/Chesapeake. Take exit 9, bear right onto US Rte. 17 north (Bridge Road). At the fourth traffic light take a left onto Shoulder's Hill Road (gas station will be on the left and a Walgreen at the adjacent corner). Go approximately ¼ mile and make a right at the first traffic light onto Bennett's Creek Park Road (school will be on the right). Continue on this road to the stop sign, take a left and enter into the park. Go to the end of the field on the left to the first pavilion on the left.

From the South/West: Take either US Rte. 58 or 460 east (towards Norfolk). Get onto the 58 by-pass and continue east. Get onto I-664 north, take exit 9A onto US Rte. 17 north and follow the above directions.

- Please bring your own shade. Running water and full restrooms are available.

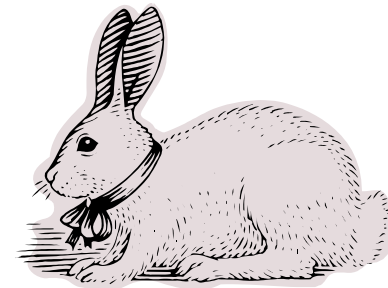
Field and Equipment Information: A battery-powered, continuous loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags. The field is mowed grass and basically level.
