

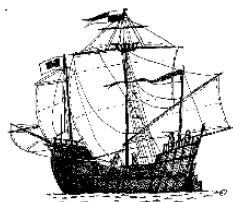
HEY, GREYHOUNDS COME OUT AND PLAY!

ELIGIBILITY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or part of an AKC registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the suffix titles of JC, SC and MC. Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending" Breed disqualifications apply. **Note:** Italian Greyhounds are not eligible to compete for Best In Field.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hounds must be one year of age (or older) on the day of the trial. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. All hounds will be examined for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered. Bitches in season may not compete.

- The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions.
- An **enforced \$5.00 fine** will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in a course in progress.
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judges and handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
- Entries will **NOT** be acknowledged by mail, but *will* be acknowledged by email if email address is provided on entry. **IMPORTANT:** FAX, E-MAIL or PHONE entries cannot be accepted.

Right after BIF and ribbons we will run a**

WANNABEE COMPETITION

For non-sighthound dogs (sorry, no wolf-hybrids). It is "just for fun"... the two classes offered are **BIG** and **LITTLE**. Dogs run the course once, solo, and will be judged on the usual lure coursing attributes. Cute and/or silly behaviors may also count at the judge's discretion. Ribbons offered. Sign-up sheet will be out during the Saturday trial. Payment must be made to the Field Trial Secretary at the time of sign-up.

PRACTICE

Immediately following the Wannabees for as long as people want to run, and we have enough light to pickup the field.

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North/West: I-64 east to exit 234, Rte 199 east towards Lightfoot. Exit Rte. 199 at Monticello Ave. and bear right onto Rte. 321/Rte. 5000 west. Proceed straight for approximately 7 miles. Monticello Ave or Rte. 5000 will turn into John Tyler Hwy or Rte. 5. The park will be the last driveway on the right hand side of Rte. 5 before the Chickahominy River bridge.

From the East: I-64 west to exit 242 towards Jamestown, Rte. 199 west. At Monticello Ave exit bear left and continue with *From the North/West* directions.

From the South: Take Rte. 31 north to the Jamestown Ferry. After crossing the river continue on Rte. 31 to Rte. 614 (first left after the Jamestown Beach Campsites). Stay on Rte. 614 to Rte. 5, make a left onto Rte. 5 and proceed to the Chickahominy Riverfront Park on right.

Alternate Route from the West: Take Rte 5 east from I-295. Turn left after crossing the Chickahominy River Bridge into the park.

TEST/TRIAL HOURS: 8:00 a.m. until dusk

ROLL CALL: 9:00 a.m. for all breeds

Earlier roll call for Field Trial Committee, club members, lure operators and judges.

*** TEST WILL PRECEDE TRIAL ***

If a hound passes the required QC test and the owner/handler wishes to enter the subsequent trial, the AKC Coursing Director has granted this club permission to accept trial entries following the test. Entries in this case will be accepted for a period of 15 minutes following the announced completion of the QC test. It is recommended that hounds entering the open stake for the 1st time have successfully practiced with other hounds before competing.

Test Offered:

Junior Courser (JC) ~ Open to all sighthounds of an AKC eligible breed. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600 yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualifying Courser (QC) ~ Open to all sighthounds of an AKC eligible breed. A Qualifying Hound running with another hound of the same breed – or another breed with a similar running style – (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound.

Stakes Offered:

Open Stake ~ Open to all hounds of a breed who have obtained at least one of the following:

1. AKC Junior Courser and have competed in a trial prior to January 1, 2010.
2. AKC Qualifying Courser. (Submit QC certificate at hound's first trial).
3. Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). (Must submit a copy of title upon initial entry.)

Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed twice within 6 trials) from Field Trials may not be entered.

Open Veteran Stake ~ Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Specials stakes and meet the age requirements for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club. Championship points will be awarded.

Specials Stake ~ Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship title. No championship points are awarded from this stake.

Best In Field will be offered.
